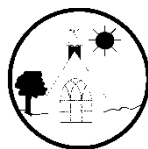

Pupil Premium Spending for 2014-15

Ten children qualified for the pupil premium grant between 2014 and 2015. This includes children who currently qualify for Free School Meals and also the children who fall into the Ever6 Category (children who have qualified for FSM over the past 6 years).

We have no children looked after and no children from parents in Service.

The total funding allocated for 2014-15 was £15,600.

10 children were all in Key Stage 2.

Academic progress for all children was good and broadly in line with non-pupil premium pupils.
