- ✂ Provide further staff training to ensure continued professional development and high quality teaching and learning in PE and Sport.
- ✂ Continue to provide a wide range of opportunities for all pupils to participate in a variety of extra-curricular clubs at no financial cost to our families.
- ✂ Continued membership of Welwyn and Hatfield School Sports Partnership and Youth Sports Trust and continue to participate in as many partnership events/festivals, access to staff and pupil training.
- ✂ To maintain Quality Mark status from the Youth Sports Trust through further extending partnership links with Sports Organisations
- ✂ Develop further links with local clubs and sporting venues (through class visits and Clubs visiting the school during Sports Week) to encourage children to take up more physical activity outside of school.
- ✂ Continue to raise the profile of Sport through the website, newsletter and awards assemblies – fixtures, achievements etc.
- ✂ Purchase further equipment to continue supporting extra-curricular and enrichment opportunities for Sport and PE, and active play in the playground.
- ✂ Develop the role of the pupil council and Sports Ambassadors - to enable pupils to provide feedback and contribute to future development of PE and Sport in our school.
- ✂ Continue to focus on Health and Well-being in the PE curriculum through a variety of physical activities and teaching and in extra-curricular opportunities – aim for children to be active during school time for at least 30 minutes every day and reduce overweight % in the school.
- ✂ Develop the playground and field area to increase space for the children to be active at play and lunchtimes.
